NSEAD adheres strictly to the requirements of the UK Data Protection Act 1998.

What we collect

This is what we normally collect about you:

- Name, address, email, telephone number, fax number, details of the school/organisation you work for, and payment details.
- Information on how you use our website to help us develop and improve our website, including details of your domain name and Internet Protocol (IP) address, operating system, browser version, how long you stayed on a page, the route you took to navigate through the pages and the website that you visited prior to accessing our site. We use Google Analytics to collect this information but do not share this information with anyone.

Using your information

The main uses of your data are:

- To provide your membership services
- To provide access to members only sections of the website
- To administer membership and keep up to date records
- To complete bookshop sales
- To enable us to review, develop and improve the products and services
- From time to time, we may also use your information to contact you for research purposes.

We will not sell, distribute or pass your personal information to third parties except in accordance with this policy or where we are required to do so by law.

Cookies

Cookies are small pieces of information stored by your internet browser onto your computers hard drive. NSEAD uses cookies to make a link between you and the information you have provided on our website. You can manually disable and enable cookies. This process will depend on your browser and is usually part of your Security Settings.
