- ❖ Artists with a graduate qualification in art and design who have an interest in education

Designed to meet the individual needs of participants, the course will support participants' personal practice, or for those who would like more structured support, set the framework for a project. Access and technical support is available in the printmaking, casting and

Photoshop studios. This course aims to benefit subsequent teaching in the classroom.
