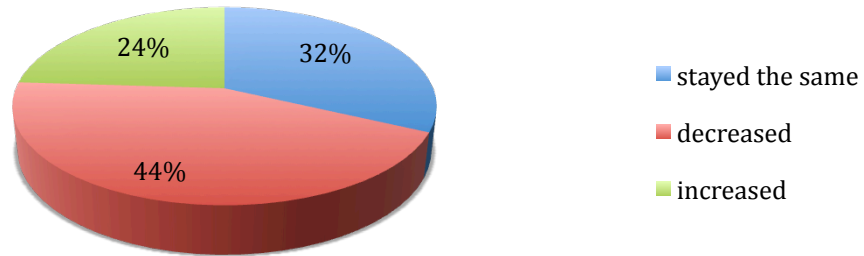
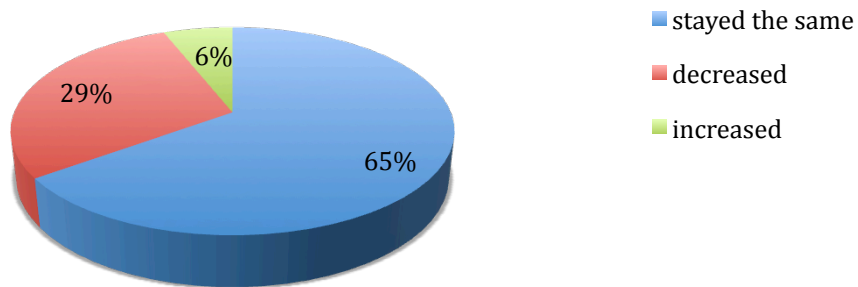


NSEAD Educator Survey – The impact of the English Baccalaureate policy (2011-14) on art, craft and design education

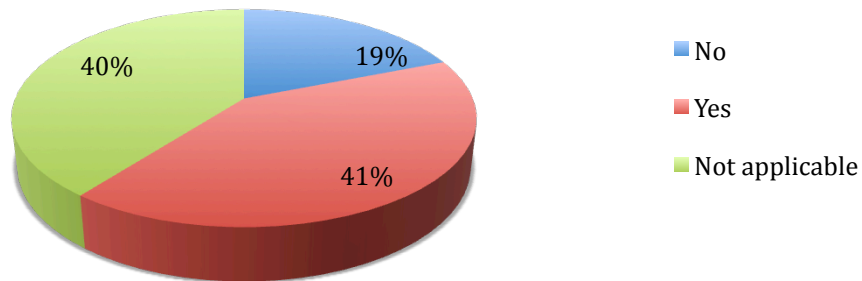

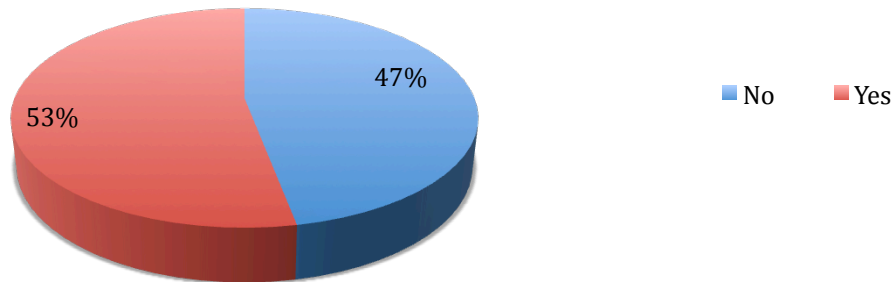
2. In the last two years, or next year (2013-14), have the **number of option blocks** where GCSE art, craft and design is offered: stayed the same, decreased or increased?



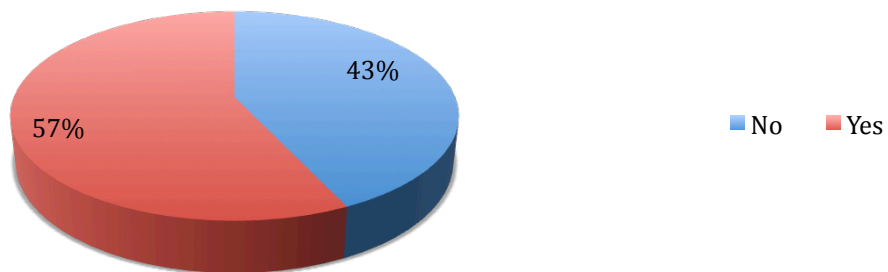

5. Has your department's **capitation** changed in the last two years or are there any plans to make reductions in the next academic year (2013-14)?



Headlines for schools and colleges, 2011-14

44% report a decrease in students taking art, craft and design

29% report a reduction in the number of option blocks

41% a reduction in vocational courses

53% report a reduction in vocational courses

57% report a decrease in capitation with teachers reporting that it is the lowest in 20 years; another noted that ring-fenced money for visits had been removed and one teacher reporting they are funding the department themselves.
